- 5. **A mini-vacation.** This is perfect for taking gift #4 to the next level. Throw in a place to stay, a gas card or two, and some spending money (and/or childcare), and you've got a fantastic and memorable gift sure to recharge your pastor for more great ministry.

Especially if your pastor has a multi-church district or a long commute, an Audible membership is a great gift to help him or her multitask by "reading" between visitations, on the way to the office, or even while exercising.
- 8. **Yard work.** Older children or youth could offer their services to mow lawns, rake leaves, or shovel snow at the pastor's home. This will save the pastoral family some effort and will add some precious family time back into their schedule!


