Complete the ACP and qualify to send an additional 5 messengers!

Messengers to the 2022 N.C. Baptist Annual Meeting approved changes to the articles and incorporation regarding what constitutes a partnering church. Those changes specified that a church which completes an Annual Church Profile (ACP) at least ninety (90) days prior to an annual meeting will be eligible for 5 more messengers than were elected by the church and registered at the previous annual meeting, up to a maximum of 10 messengers.

This is a benefit to your church because:

- A partnering church may receive 5 additional messengers than the number of messengers registered at the last annual meeting, if they **do complete** the ACP.*
- A newly partnering church that **does complete** an ACP will qualify for 5 messengers.*
- If a partnering church **does not complete** the ACP, it will qualify for only 2 messengers.
