



Jonathan tells how God has brought him through challenge after challenge. You'll be infused with hope as he shares his story of how God has changed his life through the Power of the Cross of Jesus Christ.

About Our Speaker: Jonathan is an ordained Evangelist who recently served as an interim pastor for The Revolution Church in Garner, NC. He has also served as a delivery driver for Kennedy Office out of Raleigh, NC; the Hospitality Director for Chick-fil-A and as an Assistant Varsity Basketball Coach for Calvary Day School in Winston Salem, NC.
