

POSITION AVAILABLE FOR WORSHIP MINISTRY ASSISTANT MUSICIAN

First Baptist Church of Burlington is searching for a part-time pianist who would assist the Director of Music in the preparation and performance of music in two Sunday morning services.

Responsibilities:

The Worship Ministry Assistant Musician ideally would aid the Director of Music through the following functions:

- 1) Playing piano and/or organ at the 11:00 am Sunday services.
- 2) Playing for some or all of Sanctuary Choir rehearsals.
- 3) Playing an instrument, preferably piano or guitar, and/or sing for the 9:00 service.
- 4) Serving as worship leader in the early service.
- 5) Attending or leading musical rehearsals for the 9:00 service.

Qualifications/Skill Set:

First Baptist has two Sunday services: a 9:00 casual service and an 11:00 traditional service. This musician would need to be able to play piano and understand both contemporary and traditional styles of church music. This entails being comfortable reading and performing from both written sheet music and chords/lead sheets.

Time Commitment:

Currently, the musicians for the early service practice on their own during the week, then come together on Sunday morning at 7:45 to rehearse for the 9:00 service. For the 11:00 service, the choir meets at 10:30 before the service to review music and Wednesday nights from 7:00-8:30.

Salary:

This position pays \$20/hour, not exceeding 10 hours a week. This would encompass Sunday's morning services and practices and any weekly practices for those services. These hours and schedule can be flexible as needed up front, as long as there is consistency in attendance.

There is also negotiation for help with travel expenses, if the candidate needs to come from farther than 20 miles away.
